

ORDINANCE 27-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING AN ADDITIONAL \$50,000.00 FROM THE RESERVE FOR FILTRATION FOR THE 2004 WATER UTILITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Ordinance 9-2004 of the Borough of Madison appropriated \$340,000.00 from the Reserve for Filtration for the 2004 Water Utility Program; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer advises the lowest apparent water main replacement bid received on the base bid (Hillside Avenue and Kings Road Phase 2) was in the amount of \$390,000.00; and exceeds the total appropriated amount by \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate an additional \$50,000.00 for the 2004 Water Utility Program; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Reserve for Filtration in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$50,000.00 from the Reserve for Filtration for the 2004 Water Utility Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$50,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Reserve for Filtration for the 2004 Water Utility Program.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
