

ORDINANCE 34-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$25,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR REPLACEMENT OF TELEPHONE SYSTEM AND ANNUAL COMPUTER UPGRADE AT THE MADISON PUBLIC LIBRARY

WHEREAS, the Director of the Madison Public Library has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$25,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the replacement of the telephone system including installation of a generator to protect the telephone system and for computer upgrade at the Madison Public Library; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$25,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for said improvements to the Madison Public Library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the replacement of the telephone system including installation of a generator to protect the telephone system and for computer upgrade at the Madison Public Library.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
