

ORDINANCE 35-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$11,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF COMPUTERS AND MEMORY FOR USE WITH THE PURCHASING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Borough Purchasing/Personnel Officer has recommended the Borough appropriate \$11,000.00 to purchase computers and memory for use with the purchasing system; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$11,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$11,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase the above described computers and memory for use with the purchasing system; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$11,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of computers and memory for use with the purchasing system.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
