

ORDINANCE 20-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$23,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF LAND USE SERVICES OPERATIONS SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has recommended the Borough appropriate \$23,000.00 to purchase land use services operations software, a network based integrated tracking system for planning and zoning applications, construction permits, and general complaint tracking; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$23,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$23,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase the above described land use services operations software.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$23,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of the above described land use services operations software.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
