

ORDINANCE 8-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER A238-9 OF THE BOROUGH CODE REGARDING QUORUM OF THE MADISON-CHATHAM JOINT MEETING

WHEREAS, the Madison-Chatham Joint Meeting has amended its bylaws to provide that no business shall be transacted at any meeting of the Joint Meeting unless three members of each governing body are present, however, the Finance Committee and/or Operating Committee may each take action at a meeting where at least one member of each governing body is present provided that such action shall not be binding on the Joint Meeting or the Borough of Madison or the Borough of Chatham unless subsequently concurred in by resolution of the respective Council of each municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Madison desires to amend the Borough Code to reflect such changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison in the County of Morris in the State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Madison Borough Code section A238-9 "Quorum" shall be amended to read as follows: "No business shall be transacted at any meeting of the Joint Meeting unless three members of each governing body are present, however, the Finance Committee and/or Operating Committee may each take action at a meeting where at least one member of each governing body is present provided that such action shall not be binding on the Joint Meeting or the Borough of Madison or the Borough of Chatham unless subsequently concurred in by resolution of the respective Council of each municipality."

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
