ORDINANCE 13-2009

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 147 ENTITLED "FEES FOR PUBLIC RECORDS AND DOCUMENTS" ESTABLISHING/ INCREASING FEES FOR POLICE RECORDS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Acting Police Chief has recommended that Chapter 147-1C entitled "Police records" of Chapter 147 of the Borough Code entitled "Fees For Public Documents and Records" be amended to increase certain fees and establish a fee for fingerprinting; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council agrees with this recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey that Chapter 147 of the Borough Code entitled "Fees for Public Documents and Records" shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 147-1C entitled "Police records" is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 147-3C Police records.
(4) Incident verification letter and Letters of Good Conduct: \$10.00.
(5)
(7) Fingerprinting for firearms, real estate, etc.: \$15.00 per card.
SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
