

1 ORDINANCE 21-2009

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING
\$2,000.00 FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TRUST FUND FOR THE
PURCHASE OF RESCUE LIFT BAGS**

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$2,000.00 from the Fire Department Trust Fund to purchase three Rescue Lift Bags; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Fire Department Trust Fund in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$2,000.00 from the Fire Department Trust Fund to purchase three Rescue Lift Bags; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Fire Department Trust Fund to replace the compressor on the Hartley Dodge Memorial chiller for the air conditioning.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
