ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$32,000.00 FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TRUST FUND TO PURCHASE NOTEBOOKS AND TABLETS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$32,000.00 from the Fire Department Trust Fund to purchase and install notebooks and tablets; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the Fire Trust Fund in an amount not to exceed \$32,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$32,000.00 from the Fire Trust Fund to purchase and install notebooks and tablets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$32,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Fire Department Trust Fund to purchase and install notebooks and tablets.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
