

ORDINANCE 45-2017

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON RESCINDING CHAPTER 134-9 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES" PERMITTING RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKING AT THE PUBLIC WORKS FACILITY

WHEREAS, Chapter 134, Section 9 of the Borough Code, adopted July 9, 2001, permitted residents to park recreational vehicles at the Public Works Yard on Johns Street; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Administrator has recommended that Section 134-9 be rescinded effective March 31, 2018, due to a need by the Borough to utilize the property for government use.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and the State of New Jersey that Section 134-9 of Chapter 134 of the Borough Code be rescinded; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 134, Section 9 entitled "Recreational Vehicle Parking" of the Borough code be amended to remove Chapter 134, Section 9 in its entirety.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
