ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$130,000.00 FROM THE WATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BACKHOE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Public Works Superintendent has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$130,000.00 from the Water Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a backhoe for use at the Public Works Garage; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the Water Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$130,000.00 from the Water Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a backhoe for use at the Public Works Garage; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$130,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a backhoe for use at the Public Works Garage.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
