

ORDINANCE 7-2012

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING
\$11,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR
PURCHASE OF FOUR SETS OF FIREFIGHTING TURNOUT GEAR**

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$11,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for purchase of four sets of firefighting turnout gear; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2012 Capital Budget recognized this expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$11,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$11,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for purchase of four sets of firefighting turnout gear; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$11,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for purchase of four sets of firefighting turnout gear.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
