

COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

The following is a recap from the Borough of Madison Council Meeting on Monday, May 9, 2016.

Mayor Conley recognized National Nurses Week and National Police Week. Engineer Bob Vogel gave an update on the [recent road projects](#), including [Milling and Overlay](#).

Council discussed and approved the introduction of numerous capital [ordinances](#) including:

- Electric Capital: Purchase of transformers, substation security fencing, security cameras, automated meters & handheld meter reading devices.
- Water Capital: Purchase of excavator, various well upgrades and other water system improvements.
- General Capital: Purchase of vehicles for Public Works and the Fire Department, various public safety equipment including replacement of 1976 Jaws of Life, storm water system & sanitary sewer improvements, North Street pump station repairs.
- Open Space: Additional funds for Bayley Ellard field improvements.
- Council discussed and approved the introduction of ordinances including funding improvements to Prospect Street, purchasing of a police vehicle, and updating the water and sewer connection fees. Various resolutions were passed including resolutions of support for Sustainable Jersey action items, appointment of a part time custodian, and approval of an Eagle Scout project.
