### Madison Community Garden

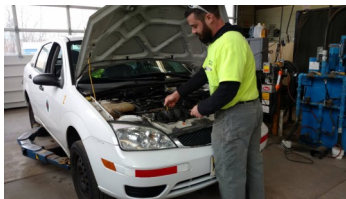
