Fall 2012 Leaf Collection: Message from the Borough of Madison Department of Public Works

The town offers three ways for residents to dispose of their leaves:

Leave containers at the Curb: Weekly curbside collection of yard waste in containers will start March 12, 2012 and continue until December 19, 2012. **We encourage using containers for leaf collection as it is efficient, environmentally friendly and the best option for storm water management. Free leaf bags are available at various municipal offices for Madison residents.**

Bring to Municipal Garage: Residents can bring leaves to the Municipal Garage on weekdays from October 22 to December 7, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. Note, this is weekdays only and no commercial dumping is allowed.

Rake to Curb: Collection will start on October 22 and weather permitting will continue until early December. ****Please get your leaves to the curb as soon as possible. November 30 is the last day to put out your leaves.****

In order to make curbside collection of leaves more efficient, place the leaves in the street. This allows our workforce to use front-end loaders for pickup when leaves are wet. Please call the Department of Public Works at 973-593-3088 if you require any additional information.

Recycling Helps to Reduce Property Taxes

In addition to the environmental benefits, recycling can help reduce property taxes. The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority charges the Borough nearly \$100 for every ton of garbage we bring to the transfer station. On the flip side, the Borough IS PAID on average \$40 for every ton of recyclable material. So, the Borough saves over \$140 for every ton of material that is recycled instead of thrown in the garbage.

The most valuable materials are paper and cardboard. As such, the Borough encourages all residents to have a paper recycling container in a convenient location in their home such as their kitchen. Cereal boxes, newspapers, office paper and junk mail are all valuable and heavy.



Electronic Recycling

Madison residents and businesses may drop off recyclable electronic items to P.C. Problems at 50 Main Street. Items include VCR's, speakers, stereo equipment, computers and computer-related equipment, fax machines, scanners, printers, copy machines, cellular phones and other wireless devices. P.C. Problems' hours are Monday-Friday: 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday: 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Sunday: Closed. Their phone number is 973-377-7711 if you need to contact them.

TV's should not be dropped off at PC Problems, but can be dropped off at the Department of Public Works Yard on John Avenue. Please call 973-593-3088 for details.

Garbage, Yard Waste and Household Hazardous Waste

The recycling district and the district used for garbage/yard waste are the same sections of town (except where noted * for garbage).

Garbage

The Borough offers residents three garbage collection options:

1. **Free Regular Curbside Pickup:** Once a week curbside pickup from September – April, twice a week curbside pickup from May 1 to August 31.
2. **Traditional Rear Yard Pickup:** Residents can contract to have their garbage taken from behind or along the side of their home for an annual fee of \$120. Once a week rear yard pickup from September – April and twice a week rear yard pickup from May 1 to August 31.
3. **NEW Enhanced Rear Yard Pickup:** Year round, twice a week pickup from behind or along the side of a residence for an annual fee of \$200. The pickups will occur on your regular, twice a week schedule, District 1A and 1B on Monday & Thursday, District 2A and 2B on Tuesday & Friday and District 3 on Wednesday & Saturday.

Residents interested in rear yard pickup should contact the hauler, Suburban Disposal, at 973-227-7020. The hauler will directly bill each resident.

- Each container cannot exceed 80 lbs.
- No construction material, grass, leaves, medical waste or recyclables.
- NO GARBAGE can be put in corrugated cardboard boxes. Corrugated must be recycled.
- If a Holiday occurs on your collection day, pickup will occur on the next scheduled pickup day.

Proper Packing

All items must be placed at the curb by 7 a.m. on the day of collection but not earlier than 7 p.m. the previous day. All containers must be removed from curbside prior to 8 p.m. on your collection day. If garbage or recyclables are not put out properly, they will not be collected.

Yard Waste Curbside Collection Period - March 12 To December 19

- Place in containers no larger than 30 gallons, or biodegradable paper bags. NO plastic bags!
- Limited to grass, weeds, leaves, hedge trimmings & tree prunings.
- Containers should have handles, not exceed 80 lbs, and **materials cannot stick out more than 1 foot from the top of the container.**
- Twigs and branches up to two inches in diameter, may be tied in 4 foot bundles, or put in reusable containers.
- Logs more than two inches in diameter must be cut to a maximum of three feet in length, and will be collected with the garbage.
- If a holiday occurs on your collection day, pickup will occur on Thursday of that week.

Yard Waste - During Non-Curbside Collection Period (after January 7)

- Yard waste, including Christmas trees, may be brought to the Borough Garage Recycling Center on John Avenue on Saturday, January 7, 2012 and Saturday, February 18, 2012, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, Freezers, or White Goods

- Special arrangements must be made for pickup of these items. Call 973-593-3088. A charge of \$25 for refrigerators/freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, stoves, washers, dryers, metal sinks, hot water heaters, etc is required. Payment is required in advance. Pickup occurs on Fridays, except on holidays when it will be picked up on a Thursday.

Motor Oil, Tires and Batteries

Motor oil, used tires, and car batteries can be properly disposed of at many local service stations, or through the Morris County Household Hazardous Waste program.

Household Hazardous Waste

The Morris County Municipal Utilities Authority offers two household hazardous waste collection days in eastern Morris County (usually on a Saturday in April and September). The County also has a permanent site located in Flanders with appointments available throughout the year to bring materials there. For information, call the County at 973-829-8006. Some of the materials accepted include pesticides, herbicides, oil based paints/stains, paint thinners, antifreeze, motor oil, transmission/brake fluid and batteries.

Garbage: Thursdays, with extra pickup on Mondays from May 1– August 31.

District 2A

Recycling & Yard Waste: Tuesdays
Garbage: Tuesdays, with extra pickup on Fridays from May 1 – August 31.

District 2B

Recycling & Yard Waste: Tuesdays
Garbage: Fridays, with extra pickup on Tuesdays from May 1 – August 31.

District 3

Recycling & Yard Waste: Wednesdays
Garbage: Wednesdays, with an extra pickup on Saturdays from May 1 – August 31.

*Recycling & Yard Waste Collection changed to Wednesdays.

Businesses

Recycling by Madison businesses **MUST BE DONE** by either using a private hauler, or by bringing the materials at no charge to the Recycling Area at the Madison Borough Garage on John Avenue on Mondays and Fridays between 9 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

How To Recycle

Newspapers and Magazines

Newspapers, magazines, cardboard, catalogs, telephone books and junk mail should either a) be placed in a container, b) tied in small bundles, or c) placed in paper grocery bags. Also, do not place materials in the gutter on rainy days.

Weekly Collection

The Occupational Center collects recyclables every week. The material you set out at the curbside will alternate week to week. Commingled bottles and cans one week; newspapers and magazines the next and so on.

A Word About Plastics

All plastic items coded ♻ through ♻ can now be recycled.

Please Rinse

Rinse your food and beverage containers. Remove lids and caps. There is no need to remove labels. Flatten your plastic containers to save space.

Food And Beverage Containers

Glass, aluminum, tin and steel food and beverage containers and plastic soda, milk, water and detergent bottles may be mixed

together and should be placed at the curb in a rigid reusable container such as a crate, bucket or garbage can, no more than 50 lbs. in weight or 30 gallons in size. Do not use bags. If you do not use the proper container, it will not be collected.
