## **ORDINANCE 34-2005**

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$65,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR SANITARY SEWER MAIN REHABILITATION PROJECTS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$65,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for sanitary sewer main rehabilitation projects; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$65,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for sanitary sewer main rehabilitation projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$65,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for sanitary sewer main rehabilitation projects.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
