## ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$105,777.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR SERVER UPGRADE

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Administrator has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$105,777.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for server upgrades; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$105,777.00 for this purpose; and
