ORDINANCE 41-2005

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$8,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR CLOCK TOWER REPAIR AT THE MUSEUM OF EARLY TRADES & CRAFTS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Administrator has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$8,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the repair of the clock tower at the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$8,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the repair of the clock tower at the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$8,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the repair of the clock tower at the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
