

ORDINANCE 30-2004

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$38,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO FENCING AT ROSEDALE AVENUE AND LUCY D. FIELDS

WHEREAS, the Recreation Director has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$38,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for improvements to fencing at Rosedale Avenue and Lucy D. Fields; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$38,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$38,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for improvements to fencing at Rosedale Avenue and Lucy D. Fields.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$38,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for improvements to fencing at Rosedale Avenue and Lucy D. Fields.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
