ORDINANCE 16-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$25,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PICK-UP TRUCK FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$25,000.00 to purchase a pick-up truck to replace the 15 year old Truck #5 which is used daily in the Fire Department as an inspectors vehicle and is scheduled for replacement; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$25,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a replacement pick-up truck for the Fire Department; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a replacement pick-up truck for the Fire Department.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
