ORDINANCE 28-2003

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE COMMUNICATIONS DESK

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Police Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of an air conditioning system to replace the non-functioning system currently at the police communications desk; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase and installation of an air conditioning system for the police communications desk.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
