

ORDINANCE 29 - 2003

ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON FIXING
SALARIES AND WAGES FOR PATROLMEN IN THE POLICEMEN'S BENEVOLENT
ASSOCIATION LOCAL NO. 92

WHEREAS, full-time patrolmen in the Borough Police Department are represented for the purpose of collective bargaining by Local No. 92 of the Policemen's Benevolent Association (hereinafter "PBA"); and

WHEREAS, the current collective bargaining agreement between the parties expired on December 31, 2002;

WHEREAS, the Borough and the PBA reached agreement on wages, salaries and benefits for a collective bargaining agreement which shall be effective January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2005;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The attached wage schedule by job classification in the Police Department for officers is hereby established for the years beginning January 1, 2003 and ending December 31, 2005.

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall supersede the provisions of Ordinance No. 7-2000 which is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
