ORDINANCE 37-2002

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$17,500.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE ASBESTOS ABATEMENT PROJECT REGARDING BOILER REPLACEMENT AT THE PUBLIC WORKS GARAGE

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough remove and abate the asbestos found at the Public Works Garage in connection with the boiler replacement project; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$17,500.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$17,500.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the asbestos abatement project at the Public Works Garage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$17,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the asbestos abatement project at the Public Works Garage.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
