

**ORDINANCE 21-2015**

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING  
\$180,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT  
FUND TO PURCHASE ONE-TON DUMP TRUCK FOR THE PUBLIC  
WORKS DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent of Public Works has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$180,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a one-ton dump truck with accessories for the Public Works Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$180,000.00 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$180,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a one-ton dump truck with accessories for the Public Works Department.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The amount of \$180,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a one-ton dump truck with accessories for the Public Works Department.

**SECTION 2:** The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
