ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$18,797.00 FROM THE MUNICIPAL OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND AS MATCHING FUNDS TO ESTABLISH A DOG PARK AT MEMORIAL PARK

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to establish a dog park at Memorial Park; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$18,797.00 from the Open Space Trust Fund towards the match requirement for the establishment of a fenced, off leash dog park at Memorial Park; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Open Space Advisory Committee has unanimously recommended the full funding of this request; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of funds in an amount not to exceed \$18,797.00 for this purpose in the Open Space Trust Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$18,797.00 is hereby appropriated from the Open Space Trust Fund towards the cost of establishing a dog park at Memorial Park.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
