

ORDINANCE 54-2019

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING
\$363,000.00 FROM THE MUNICIPAL OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND
FOR FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS TO DODGE FIELD**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to construct a new multi-purpose bathroom/storage building at Dodge Field; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$363,000.00 from the Open Space Trust Fund for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Open Space Advisory Committee has unanimously recommended the full funding of this request; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of funds in an amount not to exceed \$363,000.00 for this purpose in the Open Space Trust Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$363,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Open Space Trust Fund towards the cost of construction of a new multi-purpose bathroom/storage building at Dodge Field.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
