ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$391,673.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A NEW RESCUE/PUMPER AND FIREFIGHTING EQUIPMENT

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Fire Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$391,673.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund towards the purchase of a new Rescue/Pumper for the Fire Department; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, funds are available in the General Capital Improvement Fund and the availability of funds has been certified by the Chief Financial Officer; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$391,673.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund towards the purchase of a new Rescue/Pumper for the Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$391,673.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a new Rescue/Pumper for the Fire Department.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
