

ORDINANCE 32-2020

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$15,228.00 FROM THE MUNICIPAL OPEN SPACE TRUST FUND FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF A DRAINAGE AND REMEDIATION CAPITAL PROJECT AT THE MUSEUM OF EARLY TRADES & CRAFTS

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to reimburse the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts for a drainage and remediation capital project at the James Building; and

WHEREAS, the James Building is owned by the Borough of Madison; and

WHEREAS, the lease between the Borough and the METC obligates the Borough to fund 50% of capital improvements in excess of \$10,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$15,228.00 from the Open Space Trust Fund for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Open Space Advisory Committee has unanimously recommended the full funding of this request; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of funds in an amount not to exceed \$15,228.00 for this purpose in the Open Space Trust Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$15,228.00 is hereby appropriated from the Open Space Trust Fund for reimbursement for drainage and remediation capital project at the Museum of Early Trades & Crafts, James Building.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
