

ORDINANCE 34-2020

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 59 SECTION 59-15 OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "FEES" REGARDING DOG AND CAT LICENSES TO INCREASE FEES

WHEREAS, the Madison Board of Health has recommended amendments to the Borough Code to increase certain fees for dog and cat licenses beginning with the January 2021 licensing term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 59 of the Code of the Borough of Madison, Section 15 thereof entitled "**Fees**" is hereby amended as follows to increase certain fees for dog and cat licenses beginning with the January 2021 licensing term:

Dog/Cat License (1 year) - Neutered	\$18
Dog/Cat License (1 year) - Non-Altered	\$21
Dog/Cat License (3 year) - Neutered	\$50
Dog/Cat License (3 year) - Non-Altered	\$60
Annual Potentially Dangerous Dog Licenses	\$250
Replacement Dog or Cat License Tag	\$5
Dog/Cat Licenses - Late Fee (Applications received after Feb 1; at the discretion of the health officer)	\$10 /mo
Kennel Operator License, annual (10 or fewer animals)	\$25
Kennel Operator License, annual (11 or more animals)	\$75
Pet shop operator licenses, annual	\$25
Animal Trap Deposit	\$40

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect immediately and upon final passage and publication as required by law.
