

ORDINANCE 10-2022

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 94 APPENDIX C OF THE BOROUGH CODE ENTITLED "ELECTRIC DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS" REGARDING ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Assistant Borough Administrator/CFO has recommended amendments to the Borough Code regarding additions and alterations to the Borough's equipment by customers of the Borough of Madison electrical system; and

WHEREAS, it would be more appropriate for any increase in electrical demand caused by changes in apparatus or electrical equipment be charged to the customer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 94 of the Code of the Borough of Madison, Appendix C, thereof entitled "RULES AND REGULATIONS" is hereby amended as follows to charge customers for increased electrical demand incurred by changes in apparatus or electrical equipment:

D. PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: ADDITIONS AND ALTERATIONS

3.67 Changes in apparatus or electrical equipment connected to the Borough's lines, either by addition or replacement, which alter the characteristics of or increase the demand upon the service, must not be made without the prior approval of the Electric Division. **If the increased electrical demand incurred by changes in apparatus or electrical equipment connected to the Borough's lines cannot be supported by the existing infrastructure, either due to electrical load or location, the infrastructure shall be upgraded at the customer's expense.**

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
