

ORDINANCE 43-2022

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$20,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PORTABLE TRAILER MOUNTED MESSAGE SIGN

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$20,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of a portable trailer-mounted Ver-Mac Variable Message Sign; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$20,000.00 from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a portable trailer-mounted Ver-Mac Variable Message Sign.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$20,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Improvement Fund to purchase a portable trailer-mounted Ver-Mac Variable Message Sign.

SECTION 2: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
