ORDINANCE 10 - 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AMENDING CHAPTER 16 “ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION” TO ADD NON-VOTING ASSOCIATE MEMBERS AND STUDENT MEMBERS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Borough of Madison Environmental Commission is currently comprised of seven members, appointed by the Mayor, one of whom must be a member of the Borough Planning Board and all of whom must be residents of the Borough of Madison; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Madison, finds that it will be beneficial to increase the membership of the Madison Environmental Commission with the addition of non-voting Associate members and Student members, as this will increase public participation in the performance of the Environmental Commission important duties.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated in their entirety, as if restated herein.

Section 2. Chapter 16 of the Borough Code, entitled “Environmental Commission”, subsection 16-2, entitled “MEMBERSHIP; QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS; AND VACANCIES”, shall hereby be amended and supplemented as follows (additions in **bold**):

- A. The Environmental Commission shall consist of seven members, appointed by the Mayor, one of whom shall be a member of the Borough Planning Board and all of whom shall be residents of the Borough of Madison.
 - (i) **Associate and Student Members. In addition to the seven regular members of the Environmental Commission, the Mayor may appoint one or more adult persons as Associate members and one or more adult persons as Student members. Associate members and Student members shall not be considered regular or alternate members of the Environmental Commission. Associate members and Student members may not vote on matters before the Environmental Commission. Associate members and Student members shall serve as volunteers in Commission matters as assigned by, and under the supervision of, the Environmental Commission chairperson. The term of Associate members and Student member shall be 1 year. Associate members and Student members need not be residents of the Borough of Madison.**

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances of the Borough of Madison which are inconsistent with the previous provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication thereof as provided by law.
