ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$450,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL FUND BALANCE FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF GREEN AVENUE (WOODLAND TO SHUNPIKE)

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Engineer has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$450,000.00 from the Capital Fund Balance for reconstruction of Green Avenue from Woodland Road to Shunpike Road; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the Capital Fund Balance in an amount not to exceed \$450,000.00 for this purpose; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Borough Council has determined that the Borough should appropriate \$450,000.00 from the Capital Fund Balance for reconstruction of Green Avenue from Woodland Road to Shunpike Road; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$450,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Fund Balance for reconstruction of Green Avenue from Woodland Road to Shunpike Road.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
