ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON APPROPRIATING \$10,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO PURCHASE SEWER PUMPS

<u>WHEREAS</u>, the Superintendent of Public Works has recommended that the Borough appropriate \$10,000.00 from the General Fund Balance to purchase sewer pumps; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance has attested to the availability of the funds in the General Fund Balance in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 for this purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The amount of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund Balance to purchase sewer pumps.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
