Important Information

- Your pet must have a valid rabies vaccine. For dogs, rabies immunizations must be valid through November 1, 2022 for a 1-year license or November 1, 2024 for a 3-year license. For cats, rabies vaccine must be current.
- NJDOH advises that boostering your pet for rabies prior to the expiration date (up to one year) is standard practice. IF your
 veterinarian determines that the vaccine is contraindicated for your pet, the vet must document this via the NJDOH
 Certificate of Exemption Form VPH-28. A copy of this form should be submitted with your application.
- Please renew by mail. Applications will not be processed in person at the Health Department. Licenses and tags will be mailed after Jan 5, 2022 or within two weeks of application after that date.
