NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Borough of Madison, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, in the Municipal Courtroom, 1st Floor, Hartley Dodge Memorial Building, 50 Kings Road, Madison, New Jersey, on **THURSDAY, DECEMBER 02, 2021 AT 10:00 AM** prevailing time, and at that time will be publicly opened and read for the **PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE/REPAIR OF SEWER PUMP STATION EQUIPMENT**. Bid prices shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days.

All bids must be submitted on the Proposal Forms furnished by the Borough. Bids on any other forms will not be accepted. **Bid documents and specifications can be downloaded online at www.bidnetdirect.com/new-jersey or can be picked up for \$2.90 at the Borough Clerk's office, 50 Kings Road, Madison, NJ from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday – Friday.**

Bids shall be addressed to the Borough Clerk, Borough of Madison, Hartley Dodge Memorial Building, 50 Kings Road, Madison, New Jersey 07940.

Each Proposal must be enclosed in a SEALED ENVELOPE, properly endorsed with the name of the Bidder, with the designation "**BOROUGH OF MADISON, SEALED BID, PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE/REPAIR OF SEWER PUMP STATION EQUIPMENT, DECEMBER 02, 2021 AT 10:00AM**". **Any envelope that is received that is not properly marked causing it to be opened prior to the bid will be invalidated.** Bids may be received by the Clerk's office before the hour designated, if they are mailed or hand delivered in person. The Borough of Madison will not be responsible for any bid that is sent by mail or other form of carrier which is lost or which arrives after the bid date and time, Thursday, December 02, 2021 at 10:00AM.

The Borough of Madison reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein and to accept any bid that will be in the best interest of the Borough of Madison according to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1.

Bidders are required to comply with the provisions of the New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act, Chapter 150 of the Laws of 1963, effective January 1, 1964.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27. Bidders must comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 52:25-24.2 (P.L. 1977, c.33, as amended by P.L. 2016, c.43)
