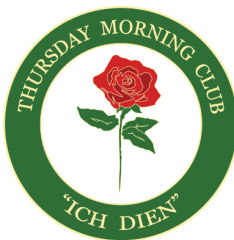
All Borough Offices (Except For Emergency Services) will be closed Monday, February 19 in observance of President's Day 2018.
