The following is a recap from the Monday, April 23, 2018 Borough of Madison Council Meeting.

Mayor Conley, read a proclamation from Chatham Borough Council thanking Madison, specifically the electric department, for the work they did to restore power to the residents that were without power due to last month's Nor'easter. Mayor Conley also presented Michael Turano, 4th grader from Central Avenue School, with his winning t-shirt design for the 20th annual May Day shirts. His winning design will be worn by nearly 1,000 people on May 5th.
