Madison, NJ – July 16, 2019 – The Borough of Madison is scheduled to host a Public Scoping Hearing on August 12, 2019 at 5:00 P.M. at Hartley Dodge Memorial, 50 Kings Road, on the proposed diversion of approximately 2 acres +/- at the Madison Recreation Complex, 184 Ridgedale Avenue (Block 601, Lot 1.01) in regards to Madison's Affordable Housing litigation and settlement efforts.
