RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF MADISON AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLE ACCESSORIES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE NEW JERSEY COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Borough of Madison desires to award a contract for the purchase of police vehicle accessories through the New Jersey Cooperative Pricing System program; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of goods and services by local contracting units is authorized by the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-10, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, Beyer Ford, has been awarded the New Jersey Cooperative Pricing System contract number 17-Fleet-00768, Police Vehicle Accessories; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Purchasing Agent has recommended that the Borough Council utilize this contract for the purchase of police vehicle accessories; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in Police Outside Duty Account, or in any other account that may be deemed appropriate by the Chief Financial Officer or his designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of Madison, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. A contract with Beyer Ford, Morristown, N.J. for the purchase of police vehicle accessories for the Police Department, in an amount not to exceed \$4,316.80 is hereby approved.
2. The Borough Administrator is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the Borough to execute a purchase order and contract to Beyer Ford, Morristown, N.J., for the purchase of police vehicle accessories for the Police Department, in a form acceptable to the Borough Attorney.
